All dioceses and eparchies have Victim Assistance Coordinators assuring that victims of abuse will be heard. In 2016, dioceses and eparchies provided outreach and support to 250 victims/survivors and their families who came forward to report abuse. Continued support was also provided to 1,510 victims/survivors and their families who reported abuse in prior years. Reflecting on God's Word

Sports reporters love to describe games in the present tense. A television announcer will say of the play that won the game, "If she doesn't get that rebound her team walks away without the win." A journalist writing for the next day's paper will write, "She sees the block coming and gets the shot off just in time." The purpose of this technique is to make us feel as though we are witnessing the event here and now.

In the scriptures that describe the events of Easter the present tense is no reporter's technique. It is the core of our belief in the Resurrection. Yes, Christ was raised from the dead two thousand years ago, but that's only the beginning of the story. Christ is risen and we are witnessing that event here and now. Those who were reborn in baptism, anointed in confirmation, and ate and drank with the Lord in the Eucharist at the Easter Vigil can attest to that truth. Christ is risen, and is filling those who believe with his life-giving Spirit today. As we give witness to our faith we would do well to follow the lead of the sports reporters and the psalmist, who sings, "This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad." Alleluia!

Reflexionemos sobre la Palabra de Dios

Los reporteros de deportes describen los partidos en el tiempo presente. Un locutor de televisión anunciará de esta manera la jugada que ganó el partido: "Si no se recupera, su equipo terminará no ganando". Una periodista que escribe para la edición del siguiente día redactará así: "Es en el tiro de esquina que se apunta el gol". El propósito de esta técnica es para hacernos sentir que estamos presenciando el partido aquí y ahora.

El uso del tiempo presente en las Escrituras que describen los sucesos de la Pascua no tiene nada que ver con la técnica de ningún reportero. Se trata del centro de nuestra fe en la Resurrección. Sí, Cristo resucitó de entre los muertos hace dos mil años, pero ése es sólo el comienzo de la historia. Cristo ha resucitado y nosotros somos testigos de ese suceso aquí y ahora. Los que han renacido en el Bautismo, han sido ungidos en la Confirmación, y comieron y bebieron con el Señor en la Eucaristía de la Vigilia Pascual pueden dar testimonio de esa verdad. Cristo resucitado derrama su Espíritu dador de vida hoy sobre todos los creyentes. Al dar testimonio de nuestra fe sería bueno seguir el ejemplo de los reporteros de deportes y del salmista, que canta: "Éste es el día en que actuó el Señor, festejémonos y alegrémonos con él". ¡Aleluya!
